Hutchings lists it in 1855. Notice of
claim filed 10/21/1852. A Calf Pasture
mine listed as late as 1936. Total
amount gold taken never recorded.

② Kelly's Bar - above Calf Bar. Notice of
intention to drain river thru the
Bar Oct 1851. An awful slaughter of
Indians took place here in May 1853.

③ Rich Bar a claim Weimar
recorded here 8/1851.
was labeled Rices Bar on
Doolittle's map of 1868

④ Jones Bar It is mentioned
in the County Hist of 1882. notice
to dam the river in Dec 1857

⑤ Barnes Bar Applegate
near Mineral Bar
It was discovered in spring
of 1849. It was named for
George Barnes who opened
a store here. Judge Robt
Thompson mined here
in May of 1849.

prospectors. Listed in Hutchings list of
towns in 1855. Interesting early Rock
House still stands from early period.


